

SUNNAT A'AMALS ON WEDDING NIGHT

1) Bridegroom should first recite two rakaat (Sunnat Niyat) Namaaz followed by praises to Allah and then 'salawaat' and following Dua:

BISMILLAHIR RAHMANIR RAHIM  
ALLAHUMMARZUKNI ULFATAHA WA-WUDDAHA WA-REZAHAA  
WA-ARZENI BEHA, WAJMA'A BAYNANA BE-AHSANE  
IJTIMA'IN, WA-AYSARE ITILAAFIN, FA-INNAKA  
TUHIBBUL HALAL WA-TUKREHUL HARAM.  
(Bride to say 'AAMIN')

2) Then bride recites two rakaat sunnat namaaz, thereafter recites following Dua:

BISMILLAHIR RAHMANIR RAHIM  
ALLAHUMMARZUKNI ULFATAHU, WA-WUDDAHU, WA-REZAHU  
WA-ARZENI BEHA; WAJMA'A BAYNANA BE-AHSANE  
IJTIMA'IN WA-AYSARB ITILAAFIN, FA-INNAKA  
TUHIBBUL HALAL WA-TUKREHUL HARAM.  
(Here bridegroom says 'AAMIN')

3) Bridegroom to recite following Dua, both facing towards 'Qibla' and bridegroom to place his hand on the forehead of bride and recite:

BISMILLAHIR RAHMANIR RAHIM  
ALLAHUMMA BE-AMANATEKA AKHAZATUHA, WABE-  
KALEMAATEKAS-STALATIHI, FA-IN FAZAYTALI MINHA  
WALADAN FAJ'ALHU MUBARAKKAN TAQIYYAN MIN SHI'ATE  
AALE MUHAMMADIN WALAA TAJ'AL LISH-SHAYTWANE FIHI  
SHIRKAN WALAA NASEEBAN.

All 'JAAEZ' (legal) Durs are fulfilled on this night

4) Then, bridegroom to rinse both feet of bride and sprinkle the water at all corners of their home.

According to Abu Saeed Bidri, the Prophet (SA) suggested the washing of bride's feet to H.Ali(AS) and said, "Ya Ali, when you bring your bride to your home, free her from all the burdens and rinse her feet and sprinkle this water in your home starting from the door and then inside, this will keep you away from

70,000 kinds of 'mohajj', it will bring in 70,000 kinds of 'barkat', and 70,000 kinds of 'rahmat' will come thru' the bride and groom and the bride will remain protected from several types of sicknesses.

5) Dua from H.ALI(AS), to be recited when I/C is intended:

BISMILLAHIR RAHMANIR RAHIM  
ALLAAHUMMA JANNIBNISH-SHAYTWANA WA JANNIBNISH-SHAYTWANA MAA RAZAKTANI.

Just before beginning of I/C, it is very important to say 'BISMILLAHIR .....' otherwise the devil also accompanies the groom in I/C, which can have major effect on the child and his/her life.

It is strongly recommended to say, "AOOZU BILLAHI MINASH-SHAYTWANIR RAJFEM" and then "BISMILLAHIR .....". It is in 'hadith' that one should NOT hasten during I/C. Foreplay and romance is essential to arouse the desire of the bride and then start I/C to give maximum satisfaction to the bride:
